* **Nature Tours-** The Palmetto Bluff Conservancy evaluates environmental conditions to ensure protection of habitats and wildlife through constant research. Rather than offering a basic nature tour, the Conservancy invites owners and guests to join them in the day-to-day research. Reservations must be made by 9:00 a.m. day of the program (**Tour begins at 9:30 a.m.**) with the Concierge. 843.706.6515 \$25/person; \$10/children 12 and under.

* **Reptile Tracking-** Join Palmetto researcher Kimberly Andrews to use radio telemetry to locate reptiles as part of our on-going research on Palmetto Bluff where we are investigating uses of local habitat types and the influences of a changing landscape on movement patterns. Space limited. Reservations must be made by 9:00 a.m. day of the program with the Concierge 843.706.6515. (**Tour begins at 9:30 a.m.**) \$25/person; \$10/children 12 and under.

* **May River Scenic Cruise-** Our antique yacht, *Grace*, will wander up the May River past Buck Point, and the Bluffton Oyster Company, the last operating oyster factory in the Southeast. On our return, we swing by the salt marshes of Palmetto Bluff and Potato Island all the while keeping an eye out for the Atlantic Bottlenose Dolphin. \$30/person; \$15/children 3-12. * **Wine Cruise-** Join us for an entertaining cruise aboard our yacht, *Grace*, while enjoying some spectacular wines. \$50/person; \$35/children 3-12. Reserve with the Concierge 6 hours prior to the trip, 843.706.6515. 2 hour cruise

* **Miss Louisa Cruise-** Cruise the internal waterway on *Miss Louisa*, our electric boat, while learning more about the abundant wildlife and rich history of Palmetto Bluff. Opportunities abound to see native birds and alligators. *Miss Louisa* departs from the internal Lagoon dock located behind The Inn. Reserve with the Concierge at least 24 hours before the cruise. 843.706.6515.

* **Daufuskie Island History & Artisan Tour-** Explore the historic sites of the island by golf cart; regular stops may include the First Union African Baptist Church, Mary Fields School (described in Pat Conroy's novel *The Water is Wide*), the Bloody Point Lighthouse, Silver Dew Pottery, Iron Fish studio and distinctive art galleries \$150/person. Limit to 6 people. Reserve with the Concierge at least 24 hours before the tour 843.706.6515- **A Palmetto Bluff Outfitters guided tour.**

* **Dolphin Eco Tour-** Depart from the Inn's dock for a casual exploration of the picturesque May River in search of some of this area's most fascinating wildlife \$110/person. Limit to 6 people. Reserve with the Concierge at least 24 hours before the tour 843.706.6515- **A Palmetto Bluff Outfitters guided tour.**

* **May River Kayak Tour-** Become enveloped in the serene beauty of the lowcountry saltmarsh estuaries with a close-up view from the seat of a kayak. No experience necessary for this laid-back tour \$80/person. Limit to 12 people. Reserve with the Concierge at least 24 hours before the tour 843.706.6515- **A Palmetto Bluff Outfitters guided tour.**

* **The "Outback"-** Your captain will choose one of several interesting routes that offer beautiful views of the lowcountry landscapes and an opportunity to observe the incredible variety of wildlife that makes this area home; dolphins, osprey, heron, bald eagle. You will then be comfortably fitted into a safe, and stable kayak for a pleasant kayak tour through remote tidal creeks. The scenery is breathtaking! \$145/person. Limit of 6 people.
